




#### A huge thank you!

is not particularly quiet, w seems to be limited.


Could be more accessible for disabled children

We love this park and spend lots of time with the family. It's so great to see so many children use it throughout the week.


Lovely space, toddler play area is a little dated and could do with upgrading!

Now we are coming out of the restrictions I have seen more and more people use it. It is peaceful and quiet and gives you time to think.

Ash Tree Pocket Park is my favourite of all the parks in Barton. An oasis of calm and a place to appreciate the beauty of the trees. I often come and sit here in the mornings and gather my thoughts. When I was recovering from a recent cancer operation I came and sat here every day. I feel sound of the wind through the branches and the calming design of the park really helped me to recover.
