

- 1 Start in Barton Village Hall car park, Crowberry Lane, DE13 8AF. Turn right and then left into Main Street.
- 2 Continue along Main Street passing The Shoulder of Mutton on your left and into Station Road passing The Three Horseshoes and The Thomas Russell Infants School. Eventually you will reach the Telephone Exchange in Station Road. Here cross the road, go through a gate and follow the path to the left around the lake to a car park.
- 3 Cross through the car park and keeping the drive on your left follow the path to the Waterfront Pub.
- 4 Here you will find a Marina, a number of shops and places to eat if you so wish. (Ice creams can also be bought!)
- 5 Now walk to the end of the shops and across the field to join the path around the lake.
- 6 When you reach the large green gate, go through it and turn left and follow the path with the sports ground on your right.
- 7 After passing the Thomas Russell Junior School turn right and walk along the path around Barton Fish Pond.
- 8 Cross the road and into Short Lane.
- 9 After passing the Fire Station and the Health Centre you will see a footpath sign. Turn right here and follow the path eventually passing the playing field and through the burial ground back to the car park in the village, where refreshments are available.





